What is Teenagers 2 Work? (T2W)

It is a work taster programme offering you the chance to experience the world of work, develop new skills and increase your self-confidence.

Work placements are varied in duration and take place during the school holidays e.g. Summer, Easter, May and October.



Who can take part?

You must be a young person aged between 15 (end of year 10) and 21 who is:

- Looked after by Durham County Council; or
- A care leaver receiving support from the Young People's Service; and
- Not currently in paid employment or training.



What do you get out of it?

- new skills and a real work experience;
- a certificate of achievement;
- certificates from the induction training e.g. Emergency First Aid;
- a financial incentive; and
- bonus allowance for full attendance.
